
WHEREAS, due to recent moisture received and lower temperatures, the danger of wildfires has decreased reducing the threat to citizens and/or property throughout Ferry County.

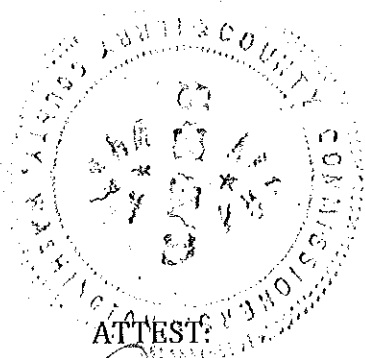


